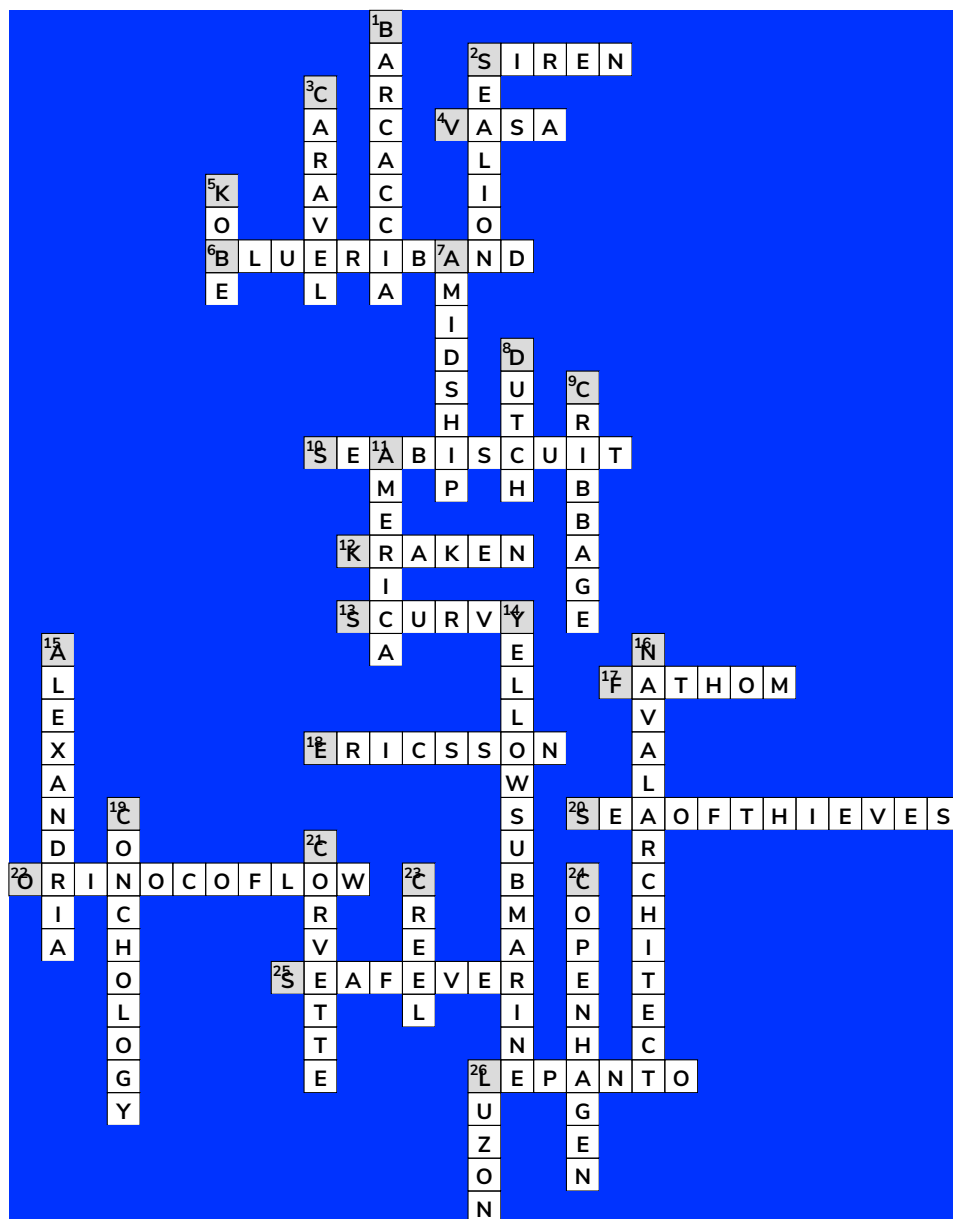

- 10 Champion American racehorse of 1930s that owes its name to a type of cracker once eaten by sailors (10)
- 12 Norwegian word used to describe a huge, mythical sea monster (6)
- 13 Disease cured by experiments started by James Lind on board a naval ship in 1747 (6)
- 17 Nautical unit of length equivalent to six feet (6)
